

The University of Suffolk is offering a £1000 award for students starting on selected undergraduate courses at the Ipswich Campus * in the academic year 2022-23. The award is available to students who enrol in September 2022 and meet specific eligibility criteria including meeting or exceeding the published entry requirements as shown on the relevant course page of our website:

- BA (Hons) Architecture
- BSc (Hons) Biomedical Science
- BA (Hons) Business Management

To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be starting on one of the above-named undergraduate degrees in September 2022 at the University of Suffolk, Ipswich Campus
- UK-domiciled
- Be assessed as a home fee payer and therefore entitled to funding for tuition fees and maintenance from Student Finance England
- Achieve grades that meet or exceed the course entry requirements as listed on the course page on the University of Suffolk website
- Be due to study your undergraduate degree on a full-time basis
- Taking examinations for Level 3 qualifications (i.e. A Levels/BTEC etc) in the academic year 2021-22 and receiving results in Summer 2022

OR

- Have taken examinations for Level 3 qualifications (i.e. A Levels/BTEC etc) in the academic year 2020-21 and have received results in Summer 2021

The £1000 award will be paid after the scheduled course start date, subject to completion of enrolment on your course. Assessments of grades achieved will be made automatically, and there is therefore no need to apply for this award.

*Courses not included on the above list, including Foundation, extended or degree apprenticeships are not eligible for this award.
