To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be starting on one of the above-named undergraduate degrees in September 2022 at the University of Suffolk, Ipswich Campus
- Be in receipt of tuition fee and/or maintenance support from Student Finance England
- Achieve grades that meet or exceed the course entry requirements as listed on the course page on the University of Suffolk website
- Be due to study your undergraduate degree on a full-time basis
- You must meet one of the following academic criteria:
  - Be taking examinations for Level 3 qualifications (i.e. A Levels/BTEC etc) in the academic year 2021-22 and receiving results in Summer 2022; OR
  - Have taken examinations for Level 3 qualifications (i.e. A Levels/BTEC etc) in the academic year 2020-21 and have received results in Summer 2021
- The £1000 award will be paid after the scheduled course start date, subject to completion of enrolment on your course and continued attendance at the point at which the award is paid. Assessments of grades achieved will be made automatically, and there is therefore no need to apply for this award.

\*Courses not included on the above list, including Foundation, extended or degree apprenticeships are not eligible for this award.
